## Free School Meals



From September 2014 all children in foundation stage, year 1 or year 2 are offered a free healthy school lunch. Children in other school years will also be offered a free school lunch if their parent is receiving any of the welfare benefits listed:

Income support, Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Income-Related Employment & Support Allowance, Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income or no more than £16,190, Guarantee element of State Pension Credit & Support via Part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999 (IAA).

## Registering could raise money for your child's school

Registering for free meals could raise an extra £1,300 for your child's school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities.

This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the welfare benefits listed above. It is therefore important to sign up for free school meals, even if your child is in foundation stage, year 1 or year 2, so that your child's school receives as much funding as possible. Application forms are available from the school office, thank you.
