Free School Meal and Pupil Premium Applications

From September 2014, all Key Stage 1 children (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) are eligible to receive free school meals. However, if you are in receipt of one or more of the benefits listed (see below) and you do not receive Working Tax Credits, Darite school could benefit from Pupil Premium funding to support your child just by filling in this application form. For more information, please speak to your child's school.

Qualifying Benefits

- Income Support
 - Income-Based Jobseeker's Allowance (not Contribution Based)
 - Income-Related Employment & Support Allowance (not Contribution Based)
 - Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income (as shown on your award letter from the Inland Revenue - TC602) of no more than £16,190.
 - Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
 - Support via Part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999 (IAA)
 - Universal Credit- if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
