Mathematics with Bubbles

Soap films and bubbles are beautiful but, surprisingly, they can also be used to solve problems that occur in nature, science and modern technology.

Over **400 children** attended a **lecture** at Plymouth University based on understanding why bubbles are round. The talk explored regular shapes, modern architecture, how whales hunt and the shortest ways to connect points.



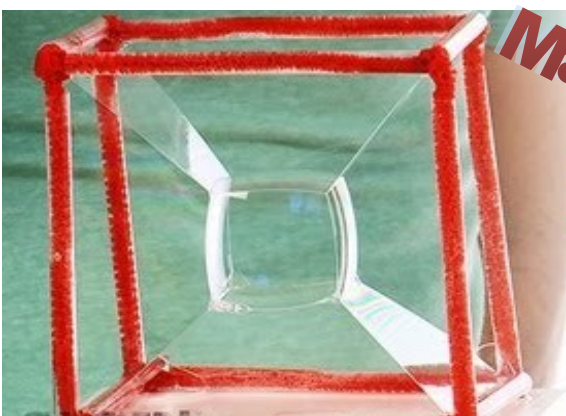
How to Make your own super strong bubble mixture

Ingredients:

- 500g sugar
- 0.75 litres of good washing up liquid (fairy liquid works well)
- 60 ml of glycerine (get it at the chemists)
- water
- patience

Instructions:

First make a sugar solution by dissolving 500g sugar in 1 litre of warm water. Then mix 0.75 litres of washing up liquid with 1 litre of water. Finally the sugar and soap solutions are mixed with 60 ml of glycerine and 5 litres of water. Use patience by leaving it overnight to mix – **this makes a big difference**. Careful – it's sticky stuff!
