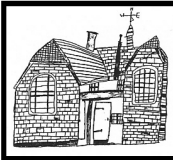

## **SCHOOL MEALS—PARENT PAY**

**As from Monday 21st May all school meals need to be paid by Parent Pay**

### **PLEASE LOG ON TO ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT**

Thank you to the parents who have already logged on to the Parent Pay website. We only have 70 parents who have activated their accounts so far. Out of those only about 4 children are booking meals a day. Others have put money in their account, but are not booking meals against it. You have to book your child's meal before midnight the day before. This meal order is then given to the cook. If you forgot to order your child's meal you cannot enter it after midnight, see Mrs Tandy who will help you to book a meal online on the day if you haven't done so.

The cook is receiving hardly any money. There are currently large amounts of money owed for school meals. The cook will be issuing reminders, so please look in your child's reading folder just in case your child has received one. Your prompt payment would be appreciated.

Meals have to be booked online and the money for the meal will then be debited to your account, you must make sure there is enough money to pay for your child's meals. We will be going online for all meals, so please make sure that you have booked online in future. Make a selection for a main meal and a dessert.

The parents who have not activated their account will receive an activation reminder letter today with the code on again. PLEASE can you all activate your account as in the future you will be paying for trips, swimming etc. via Parent Pay, as Bridge Multi-Academy Trust expect us to be a cashless school by September.

#### **A reminder of procedure:**

- ◆ Activate your account
- ◆ Pay money into your account
- ◆ Book your child's meal at the latest by midnight the day before (you can order up to 100 days meals)
- ◆ The cost of the meal will be deducted from your account once the meal is ordered
