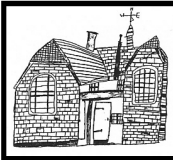

SCHOOL MEALS—PARENT PAY

As from Monday 21st May all school meals need to be paid by Parent Pay

PLEASE LOG ON TO ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT

From next Monday you do not have to select the meal from the menu.

Thank you to the parents who have already logged on to the Parent Pay website. We still have 87 parents who need to activate their accounts please. You will need this account to pay for trips as well as dinner money so all infants parents need to activate their account as well.

From next Monday you do not have to select the meal from the menu. Just keep your payments up to date. A register will be taken daily when your child orders a meal in the morning and this will debit your account for the cost of the meal.

There are currently large amounts of money owed for school meals. The cook will let us know who has debts still unpaid this Friday, we will have to debit these to your account. Please make sure your account has enough money in it to cover your child's meals.

PLEASE can you all activate your account as in the future you will be paying for trips, swimming etc. via Parent Pay, as Bridge Multi-Academy Trust expect us to be a cashless school by September.

- ◆ Pay money into your account
- ◆ The cost of the meal will be deducted from your account once the meal has been ordered by your child in class each morning.
- ◆ An attendance register for meals will be taken each day, this will then debit your account.
