



EYFS Transition to school Dates for your diary

Please find below transition information for September. This will help you to prepare your child for how school will be. Miss Pittas will also be contacting parents before term ends to offer advice and to answer any questions you might have.

Monday 7th September

We would like to invite you for an individual 'meet the teacher' session in school during the afternoon. We ask that one parent accompanies your child to enter the school office area for the start of your appointment. Please wait at the office and Miss Pittas will accompany you from this entrance into the EYFS classroom. These sessions will be informal and last approx 10 mins so you and your child get the opportunity to see their classroom and you can ask any questions. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, sadly at the moment this will be the only time that you will be able to enter the classroom and school grounds.

Tuesday 8th-Thursday 11th September

We would like to provide a daily opportunity for your child to visit their classroom this week, for afternoon sessions. Please drop your child off onto the school playground for 1.20 PM using the main entrance and not the entrance at the top of the hill. This will mean that each child has a 'car drop off'. Miss Pittas and the class TA will walk the children into school. Please wear school uniform on these visits.

Friday 11th September

We invite the children to stay for the morning session (arriving by 'car drop off' between 8.45 and 9.00 AM) and eat a packed lunch from home with Kilminorth Class children. Please collect your child at 12.30pm.

We look forward to meeting you and we hope that these transition sessions will be helpful to you and your child.
